## Chapel Hill Early School Summer Camp

\*\*Camp hours are 8:30 am - 3:00 pm; the fee is \$190 per week. **Extended Day** is an additional charge of \$60 per week: 3:00 - 5:30 pm.

Please include these documents with your registration form. We will mail confirmation letters within **10** days explaining policies and activities and including forms **you must sign**. ### Licensed Day Care

### Location

## Weekly Themes
